General Instructions

- 1) Do not install non self-support boxes without support brackets. These boxes are not manufactured to be installed without adequate support system. Brackets are sold separately. (See picture)
- 2) Drill a hole in the support brackets while keeping in mind where you plan on installing them on the truck or trailer. The minimal size for bolts is 1/2".
- 3) Drill a hole in the support brackets as well as the box. Very important, only pierce the box at the base and use 4 nuts to secure the box to the support bracket. We recommend using 3/8" to 1/2" nuts to fix the box to the brackets.

Note: Additional attachment at the back of the box with the intent toincrease stability may damage the box due to the torsion of truck and trailer chassis during turns. We strongly recommend avoiding any reinforcements through the back of the box to the support brackets.

- 4) Install the support brackets for the truck/trailer taking care that the spacing between the brackets meet the box dimensions.
- 5) Insert the box in the brackets and fix it in place.
